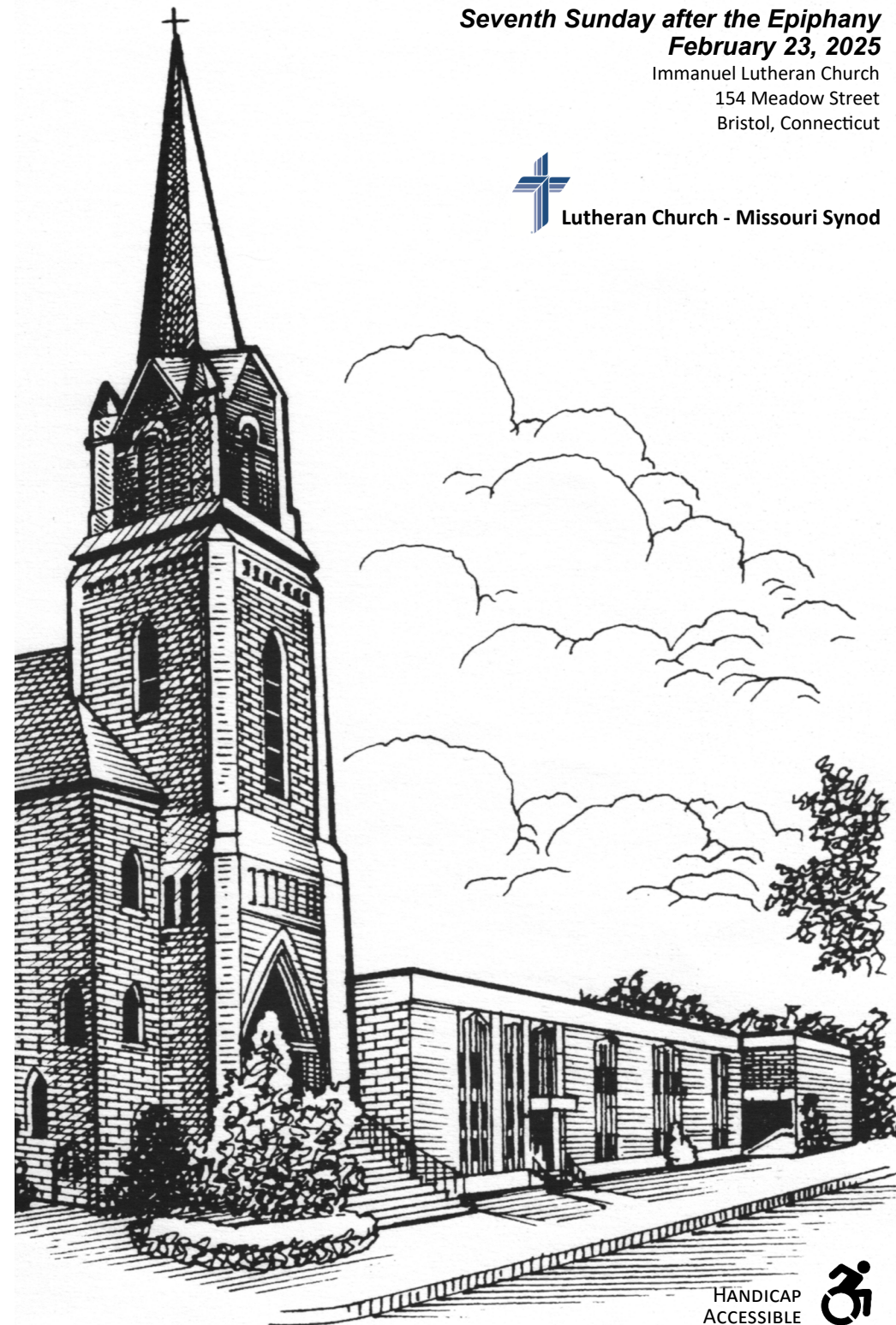

COMMUNION STATEMENT

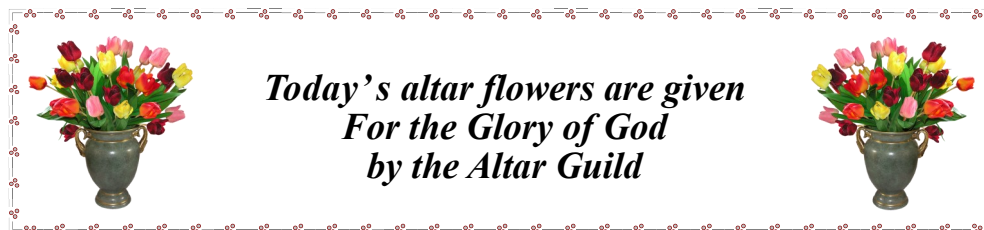
